GUARDS THEIR PHONE WITH THEIR LIFE?

A sudden need for extreme privacy—password changes, hiding screens, or never leaving their phone unattended—can signal inappropriate relationships or preparation for divorce.

HOARDS CASH?

Stockpiling cash or withdrawing money without explanation may indicate someone is quietly preparing for financial independence or anticipating upcoming legal expenses.

IMPROVES APPEARANCE?

A dramatic and unexplained focus on grooming, fitness, or wardrobe changes can suggest a shift in priorities, sometimes tied to envisioning life outside the marriage, or having extramarital affairs.

INFREQUENT SEX OR INTIMACY?

A noticeable drop in physical or emotional intimacy often reflects emotional distance, unresolved conflict, a partner mentally disengaging from the relationship, or they are being intimate with someone else.

NOT AROUND?

Working late, frequent trips, or vague explanations about their whereabouts may point to an affair—or time being spent planning next steps without their spouse involved.

UNUSUAL OR EXCESSIVE TRANSACTIONS?

Unexpected transfers, new accounts, or large purchases can be a sign of asset movement or financial positioning ahead of a potential divorce.
